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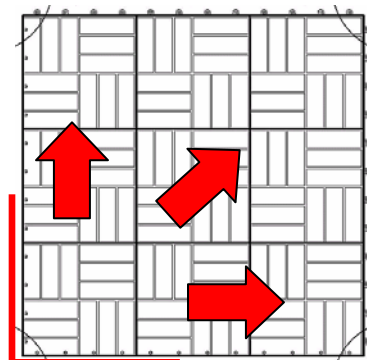
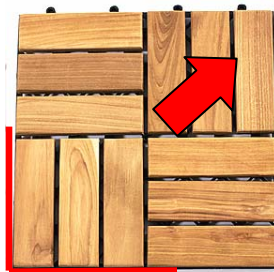


Plan - Click - Finish & Enjoy! It is that simple!



Tips to lay the tiles:

Best way to start is to placing the first tile to fit with the pin-pin side neatly in the corner or at the side from where the floor will be laid.



Then easily click the pins from the next tile into the open hole of the already placed tile. Move on along like shown by the red arrows.

- Tiles click easily into each other
- Absolutely no pressure or strength required
- Easily un-click if you want to move tiles





Using Le click® Corner Pieces and End Pieces:

We have corner and end pieces to frame a Le click® teak deck to a neatly finish.

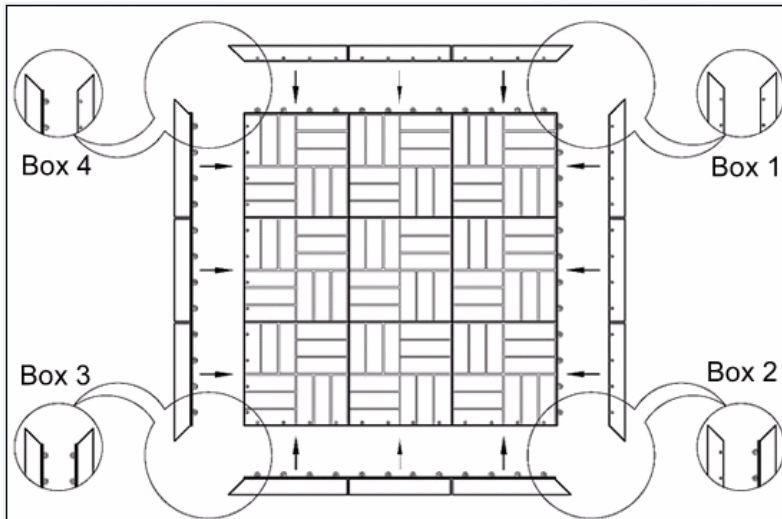
End pieces:



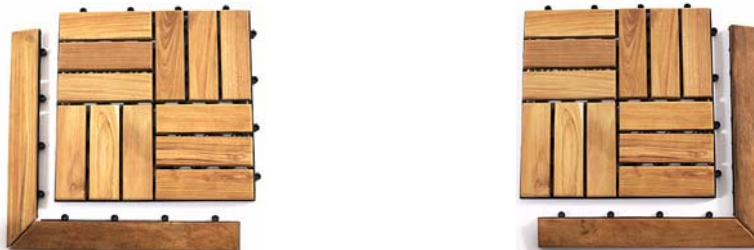
- Box of 2 pieces with hole - to click the tile pin side into the end piece
- Box of 2 end pieces with pin - to click the end piece in the open hole of the tile



Corner pieces:



- Box 1 - two corner pieces both pin
- Box 2 - two corner pieces: one with pin, one with hole
- Box 3 - two corner pieces both with hole
- Box 4 - two corner pieces: one with hole, one with pin





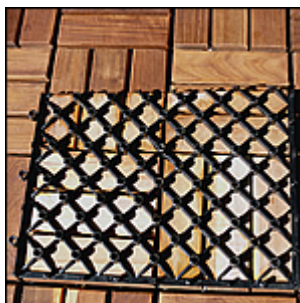
Le click© Anti-Slip rubber knobs

Planning to put a Le click© teak floor on a slippery surface like marble, tile, sealed/painted concrete or laminate flooring? Just punch 5-10 Anti-Slip rubber knobs into each tile underside and the tiles will stick to the surface like glued or bolted down.



Cutting Le click© tiles to Size

Planning to perfectly fit a floor in a given space? Le click© teak flooring tiles can be cut to size easily – use a jig-saw or blade saw and cut through the wood and PVC resin at the same time with no issues.



Screws can be easily moved to another place if in the line of cutting the tile.
